Dr Rogério Bonifácio leads the Climate and Earth Observation Unit at the Research, Assessment and Monitoring Division of the UN World Food Program HQ in Rome. After a period as a university researcher, he joined WFP's operations in Sudan in 2005 for a period of 5 years before moving to his current position in late 2009. The team he supervises carries out analytical work in the areas of climate and Earth Observation applied to food security and humanitarian interventions, having led a major increase in the uptake and application of EO data into WFP analytical processes in the past 7 years.
